Achievements under Humanitarian Response for Host Community in Cox's Bazar (HRHC) Project (Funded by DFAT & technical support with Brac)

TRAINING ON LOCALLY DRIVEN INITIATIVES

HELP Cox's Bazar provided 05 nos. of day long training to the 101 members of different community based organization on locally driven development initiatives where 79 male and 22 female participated.



TRAINING ON CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT

During this HELP Cox's Bazar provided 06 nos. of training to the members of community based organization. In each batch training participated 20 participants. Out of 127 participants 87 was male and 40 was female.



COMMUNITY MOBILIZATION SESSION

On April through this project facilitated 10 sessions to trigger community-led planning and implementation where out of 210 participants 179 was male and 31 was female.



AIGAs TRAINING AND INPUTS SUPPORT

Respond to local demand for strengthening/protecting local communities/institutions including AIGAs (training and inputs). Each batch consisting 20 members while out of 51 participants all were male.



CAMPAIGN IN COMMUNITY LEVEL

Organized 02 Community level campaign engaging adolescent girls, boys, youths of clubs or CBOs to build community level awareness and positive actions to promote peace and cohesion within the host communities where out of 42 participants, 19 was male 23 was female.



TRAINING IN CREATING INCOME/LIVELIHOOD OPTIONS

Small-scale quick impact livelihood interventions to promote income generation, food security, and skill-based development opportunities. (Training and inputs/assets). A total 9 batches training each batch consisting 20 participants and 186 nos. of participants received this training where 76 was male and 110 was female.



CONDUCT COURTYARD SESSION

During this month through this project organized 6 Court yard meeting where out of 97 participants all are female. The issues on these sessions were on gender equality, SRHR, early marriage, Gender Based Violence, Violence against women and children.





CAPACITY BUILDING TRAINING TO THE COMMUNITY VULUNTEERS

Provided 01 Capacity building training to the selected volunteers for facilitating massages on ending VAWC, Sexual harassment & Child marriage, SRHR through different forums and platforms. In this training 20 participants were participated.



ORGANIZING INTERACTIVE SESSION

Within April it was organized 01 Interactive session through the effective participation of different stakeholders to find out gender gaps where out of 20 participants 08 was male and 12 was female.



CAPACITY BUILDING TRAING FOR VOLUNTEERS

Provided 01 Capacity building to the selected 20 volunteers for facilitating massages on disability inclusion in sectoral forums and platforms.





ACTIVITY OF DISABILITY LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT CENTER (DLDC)

This learning center is a persons with disability friendly space which is well accomplished with different information i.e. Citizen Charter, list of referral service providers, recreational arrangement, Primary counseling support, Different sessions on the issues relating to rights ,problems, exchanging views with the persons with disability and their family members and receiving feedback & response etc.



Achievements under Community Engagement in Countering Violent Extremism in Chattagram Division (CEVEC) Project (Funded by GCERF):

Organized 02 Community engagement events by club & local community people where out of 101 participants 40 was male 61 was female. Through this community engagement session they gained knowledge on Preventive Violent Extremism (PVE).



 Organized 2 meetings with youth forum members on Preventive violence extremism (PVE). Out of 36 participants 18 was male and 18 was female.
